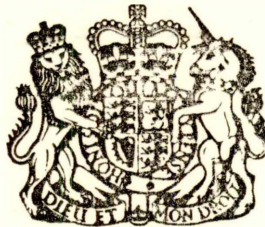

Arrangement of Sections.

Section

1. Short Title.
2. Appropriation of \$4,298,974.88 in 1957.
3. Validation of payments in 1957.

AN ORDINANCE to make provision for the appropriation to the Development Fund of certain sums of money transferred thereto from the revenues and funds of the Colony.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Development Fund (1957 Appropriation) Ordinance, 1958.

A. D. 1958.
Short Title.

Appropriation of \$4,298,974.88 in 1957.

2. The sum of four million two hundred and ninety-eight thousand nine hundred and seventy-four dollars and eighty-eight cents transferred from the revenues and funds of the Colony to the Development Fund in the year 1957 is hereby deemed to have been appropriated by law to the said Development Fund on the 1st January, 1957.

Validation of payments in 1957.

3. All payments made during the year 1957 out of the sum mentioned in section 2 of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have been validly and properly made out of the Development Fund.

Passed by the Legislative Council this tenth day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight.
