2. Insertion of section 23A in Chapter 153.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Sewerage and Water (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion after section 23 of the following —

“Appoint-  
ment of  
Director of  
Audit and  
auditing of  
accounts.

23A. (1) The accounts of the Commissioners shall at some date between the 1st January and the 31st March in each year be audited by the Director of Audit who shall give one month's notice in writing to the Secretary of the date of his intention to commence the work of audit, and at the audit any owner of any house, building or premises in Georgetown may be present and shall be at liberty to communicate with the Director of Audit on any matter relating to the accounts of the Commissioners. The expenses of the audit shall be borne by the Commissioners.

(2) Subsections (2), (3), (4), (5) and (6) of section 133 of the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance shall apply, *mutatis mutandis* and so far as they are not inapplicable thereto, to the accounts of the Commissioners.”
