AN ORDINANCE to amend the Executive and Legislative Councils (Remuneration of Members) Ordinance, 1953.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

A.D. 1960

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Executive and Legislative Councils (Remuneration of Members) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the Executive and Legislative Councils (Remuneration of Members) Ordinance, 1953, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

(2) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 10th September, 1957.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion after the word "annum" of the words "and an Elected Member of the Legislative Council shall be paid a like salary".

Amendment  
of section 7

3. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "Nominated".

4. Any payment made prior to the commencement of this Ordinance in pursuance of the special warrant under the hand of the Governor's Deputy dated the 27th September, 1957, whereby the payment of salary to Elected Members of the Legislative Council was authorised, shall be deemed to have been made in accordance with the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.
