

2. Anything in the provisions of the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957, to the contrary notwithstanding, the office of Head Carpenter, Georgetown Hospital, shall be, and is hereby declared to be a pensionable office for the purposes of that Ordinance with effect from the 1st January, 1955.
