AN ORDINANCE to make special provision with respect to the Pension of Massy Desmond ffrench-Mullen.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the ffrench-Mullen Pension Ordinance, 1960.

2. In this Ordinance —

“the Principal Ordinance” means the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957, and any Ordinance amending the same.

3. Anything in the provisions of the Principal Ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding, the service of Massy Desmond French-Mullen between the period commencing on the 1st June, 1952, and ending on the 31st March, 1956, both dates inclusive, shall for the purposes of the Principal Ordinance, be deemed to be pensionable service.
