AN ORDINANCE to confer additional powers on a Commissioner of Title.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1960.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Commissioner of Title (Additional Powers) Ordinance, 1960. Short title.

2. A Commissioner of Title may hear and determine such matters in respect of which a judge of the Supreme Court has power to exercise jurisdiction under the Title to Land (Prescription and Limitation) Ordinance or the District Lands Partition and Re-allotment Ordinance as may be assigned to him by the Chief Justice, and for that purpose shall be vested with and may exercise the powers of a judge of the Supreme Court.

3. Any order of a Commissioner of Title made in pursuance of the jurisdiction conferred on him by the preceding section shall be deemed to have been made by a judge of the Supreme Court.

Duration of
Ordinance.

4. This Ordinance shall have effect for a period of one year from the date of its coming into force, and may, prior to its expiration, be extended by resolution of the Legislative Council for a further period not exceeding one year, and may from time to time, prior to the expiration of that or any further extension, be extended for a further period not exceeding one year.
