- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Davson Centenary Fund Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964, and shall be construed and read as one with the Davson Centenary Fund Ordinance, hereinafter referred Cap. 149. to as the Principal Ordinance.
- 2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion Insertion of Section 7A in Chapter 149.

"Power to extend time.

7A. The Governor may extend the time prescribed for the doing of anything by this Ordinance or any regulations made thereunder, whether the time prescribed therefor has elapsed or not".
