AN ORDINANCE to make special provision with respect to the pensionable service of Frederick Walter Eleazar Case.

A.D. 1964. Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Case Pension Ordinance, 1964.

Interpretation. No. 38 of 1957. 2. In this Ordinance—
“the Principal Ordinance” means the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957.

Certain service of F. W. E. Case to be deemed to be pensionable service. 3. Anything in the Principal Ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding, the service of Frederick Walter Eleazar Case between the period commencing on the 27th October, 1948, and ending on the 31st July, 1951, both dates inclusive, shall be deemed to be pensionable service for the purposes of the Principal Ordinance.
