LIQUOR LICENSING (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1964.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Liquor Licensing Ordinance.

[4th July, 1964]

A.D. 1964. Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Liquor Licensing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964, and shall be construed and read with the Liquor Licensing Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Cap. 316.

Insertion of section 19A in Principal Ordinance. 2. The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after section 19 of the following section—

“Alteration of premises and refund of fee. 19A. (1) Where the Comptroller has issued a licence under section 19 of this Ordinance in respect of premises which have been altered, damaged or destroyed subsequent to the grant of the licence so that such premises no longer comply with the provisions of this Ordinance, the licence in respect of such premises shall be deemed to have been cancelled—

- (a) in the case of an alteration, from the date of the commencement of such alteration; and
- (b) in the case of damage or destruction, from the date of such damage or destruction.

(2) The licensee of such premises shall forthwith inform the Comptroller in writing of the fact of such alteration, damage or destruction and the Comptroller, may, as he thinks fit, refund the whole or any part of the licence duty paid by the licensee."
