AN ORDINANCE to regulate the publication of certain instruments in newspapers.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Statutory Publications Ordinance, 1964.

Publications in newspapers.

2. Wherever under the provisions of any law there are references requiring the publication of any order, notice, or any other instrument whatsoever in more than one newspaper or daily newspaper, from and after the commencement of this Ordinance the references aforesaid in any such law shall be construed and have effect as if there were substituted therefor references requiring the publication of any order, notice or any other instrument whatsoever to be made in only one newspaper.

Validation of certain publications.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law requiring the publication of any order, notice, or any other instrument whatsoever in more than one newspaper or daily newspaper, the publication before the commencement of this Ordinance of any order, notice or any other instrument whatsoever in only one newspaper or daily newspaper is hereby declared for all purposes to have been valid, proper and lawful.
