1. Short title.
2. Accountant General to defray expenses of Civil Government. Schedule.
An Ordinance to appropriate the supplies granted in the current Session of the Legislative Council.
WHEREAS of the amount of fifty-four million, nine hundred and forty-eight thousand, seven hundred and ninety-seven dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes, for the year commencing the first day of January, nineteen
hundred and sixty-one, the sum of five million, six hundred and eigntyone thousand, one hundred and eighty-six dollars has been providied for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of British Guiana of forty-nine million, two hundred and sixty-seven thousand, six hundred and eleven dollars:

Accountant General to defray expenses of Civil Government.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1961.
2. The Accountant General shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-one, and other resources of British Guiana a sum not exceeding in the aggregate fortynine million, two hundred and sixty-seven thousand, six hundred and
