AN ORDINANCE to provide for the declaration of the Cane Grove Drainage and Irrigation Area, the vesting of certain lands and works in the Drainage and Irrigation Board and for purposes connected with the matters aforesaid.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Drainage and Irrigation (Declaration of Area) Ordinance, 1961.

Short title.

Interpretation.

2. In this Ordinance —

“the Board” means the Drainage and Irrigation Board established under the Principal Ordinance;

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“the Principal Ordinance” means the Drainage and Irrigation Ordinance;

“work” shall have the meaning assigned to that expression in the Principal Ordinance.

3. (1) Anything to the contrary contained in the Principal Ordinance notwithstanding, but subject to the provisions of this Ordinance, the area described in the schedule hereto, shall be, and is hereby declared to be, a drainage and irrigation area for all purposes as though it had been declared to be such by order in council made under section 18, and published as contemplated under section 19 of the Principal Ordinance.

(2) The name and boundaries of the drainage and irrigation area declared under this section shall be those respectively assigned to them in the schedule hereto.

4. The Board shall cause to be prepared a plan of all works in the area described in the schedule hereto, constructed or maintained by any agent or servant of the Government prior to the commencement of this Ordinance, and the provisions of subsections (7), (8) and (9) of section 23 of the Principal Ordinance shall *mutatis mutandis* apply in relation thereto and, upon the vesting of lands in the Board by virtue of this section, the said works shall be deemed to be maintainable by the Board under section 24A of the Principal Ordinance.

## SCHEDULE

ss. 3 and 4.

The Cane Grove Drainage and Irrigation Area and bounded as follows —

On the North—by the common boundary between Plantations Veereeniging and Mary’s Hope from the eastern dam of the New Shanks Canal to the left bank of the Mahaica River.

On the East—by the left bank of the Mahaica River from the common boundary between Plantations Veereeniging and Mary’s Hope to the common boundary between Plantations Huntley and Orange Nassau.

On the South—by the common boundary between Plantations Huntley and Orange Nassau from the left bank of the Mahaica River to the eastern dam of the East Demerara Water Conservancy; by the eastern dam of the East Demerara Water Conservancy from the common boundary between Plantations Huntley and Orange Nassau to the northern dam of the East Demerara Water Conservancy; and by the northern dam of the East Demerara Water Conservancy from the eastern dam of the East Demerara Water Conservancy to the eastern dam of the New Shanks Canal.

On the West—by the eastern dam of the New Shanks Canal from the northern dam of the East Demerara Water Conservancy to the common boundary between Plantations Veereening and Mary's Hope.
