AN ORDINANCE to amend the Interpretation Ordinance.

A.D. 1961. Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title and
commence-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Interpretation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1961, and shall be construed and read with the Interpretation Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

(2) This Ordinance shall come into operation on the date on which it is published in the Gazette.

Repeal and
re-enactment
of section 10
of Chapter 5.

2. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor —

“Commence-
ment of
Ordinances.

10. Every Ordinance enacted under the Constitution of British Guiana shall be published in the Gazette and, subject to anything to the contrary in that Ordinance, shall **come** into operation —

- (a) where such enactment is effected in accordance with sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (1) of article 74 of the said Constitution, **on the date of such publication; or**
- (b) where such enactment is effected in accordance with sub-paragraph (b) of the said paragraph, on the date of the publication required by that sub-paragraph.”
