AN ORDINANCE to amend the Mining Ordinance.

[31st July, 1962]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

A.D. 1962.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mining (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, and shall be construed and read as one with the Mining Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.
Chapter 196.

2. (1) The Principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

of Chapter

- (a) by the deletion of the words and commas “,with the approval of the Secretary of State,” appearing in sections 14 and 16;
- (b) by the substitution in section 19 of a full stop for the colon appearing immediately after the word “with” and by the deletion of the proviso to the said section;
- (c) by the substitution in section 20 of the expression “Governor” for the expression “Secretary of State”;
- (d) by the repeal of section 90 and the substitution therefor of the following section —

“Moneys payable under Ordinance or regulations.

90. All royalties, duty on profits, rent, fees, and other moneys payable under this Ordinance, or under the regulations shall be paid into the Treasury for the use of the Colony.”.

(2) Wherever in any regulations made under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance the approval of the Secretary of State is required in relation to the doing of any act or thing, such approval shall no longer be required.
