## ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF 1963.

## APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE, 1963.

Arrangement of Sections.

## Section

- 1. Short title.
  - 2. Accountant General to defray expenses of Civil Government and other purposes.

Schedule.

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the supplies granted in the current session of the Legislature.

WHEREAS of the amount of Sixty-seven million, seven hundred thousand, five hundred and sixty-seven dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of British Guiana and other purposes, for the 2

year commencing the 1st day of January, nineteen hundred and sixtythree, the sum of Eight million, five hundred and twenty-six thousand, seven hundred and sixty-six dollars is chargeable by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of British Guiana of Fifty-nine million, one hundred and seventy-three thousand, eight hundred and one dollars.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1963.

Accountant General to defray expenses of Civil Government and other purposes.

The Accountant General shall on the warrant of the Governor or of the Minister responsible for Finance, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing on the 1st January, 1963, and other resources of British Guiana a sum not exceeding in the aggregate fiftynine million, one hundred and seventy-three thousand, eight hundred and one dollars as set forth in the schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes during the said year.
