ORDINANCE NO. 11 OF 1963.

WYLIE PENSION ORDINANCE, 1963.

Arrangement of Sections.

Section

1. Short title.
2. Certain period of service of Campbell Wylie not to be reckoned as pensionable service.

AN ORDINANCE to make special provision with regard to the pensionable service of Campbell Wylie.

WHEREAS, Mr. Campbell Wylie, formerly Attorney General of British Guiana, was seconded with effect from the 30th September, 1956, from the Public Service of British Guiana to the Pre-Federal Organisation set up to establish the Federation of The West Indies, and was subsequently appointed as Attorney General of the Federation with effect from the 3rd January, 1958;

AND WHEREAS it would enure to the benefit of Mr. Campbell Wylie if the period of his service commencing on the 30th September, 1956, and ending on the 2nd January, 1958, were not reckoned as pensionable service under the provisions of the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957, but as service with the aforesaid Federation: No. 38 of 1957.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:— A.D. 1963.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wylie Pension Ordinance, 1963. Short title.

2. Anything in the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957, to the contrary notwithstanding, the period of service of Campbell Wylie commencing on the 30th September, 1956, and ending on the 2nd January, 1958, shall not be reckoned as pensionable service under the provisions of the aforesaid Ordinance. Certain period of service of Campbell Wylie not to be reckoned as pensionable service.
