AN ORDINANCE to amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance.

[30th November, 1963]

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963, and shall be construed and read as one with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Cap. 280.

2. Subsection (3) of section 94 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following subsection substituted therefor—

“(3) The Board shall advise the Prescribed Authority on such matters connected with road service, hire car and goods transportation licences and other matters relating to this Part of this Ordinance, as may be referred to the Board by the Prescribed Authority.”

Validation of  
acts.

3. Any act or thing done or omitted by the Prescribed Authority under the provisions of the Principal Ordinance prior to the commencement of this Ordinance and which would have been lawfully done or omitted under the Principal Ordinance if section 2 of this Ordinance had been enacted shall be deemed to have been lawfully done thereunder.
