Short title.

Cap. 277.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Roads (Amendment) Ordinance, 1963, and shall be construed and read as one with the Roads Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (2) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended —

- (a) by the insertion therein immediately after the word “schedule” of the words “or any part of any such road”;
- (b) by the insertion after the word “road” at the end of the subsection of the words “or any part thereof as the case may be”.
