BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. / OF 1933.

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the Supplies granted in the last session of the Legislative Council. A.D. 1933.


WHEREAS of the amount of five million three hundred and sixty-seven thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of this Colony, and for other purposes, for the year to end on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, the sum of one million seven hundred and ninety-nine thousand one hundred and thirty-three dollars has been provided for by law and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony of three million five hundred and sixty-eight thousand eight hundred and four dollars :

Be it, therefore, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short Title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1933.

Treasurer to defray expenses of Civil Government. 2. The Colonial Treasurer shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony a sum not exceeding in the aggregate three million five hundred and sixty-eight thousand eight hundred and four dollars as set forth in the schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of the Colony, and for other purposes during the year ending the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.

Passed by the Legislative Council this 29th day of March, 1933.
