ORDINANCE NO. 2 OF 1934.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Foodstuffs (Export Regulation) Ordinance, Chapter 264, by extending its operation to certain animals.

A.D. 1934.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Foodstuffs (Export Regulation) Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed with the Foodstuffs (Export Regulation) Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.


