ORDINANCE NO. 4 OF 1934.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Miscellaneous Licences Ordinance to authorise the grant of a Butcher's Licence to a person who is not the holder of an Omnibus Licence. A.D. 1934.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Miscellaneous Licences Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed with the Miscellaneous Licences Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any amending Ordinance. Short Title.



“ Provided that a butcher's licence only may be granted to a person who is not the holder of an omnibus licence.”
