BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. 6 OF 1934.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Ordinance, 1933, so as to give power to extend its provisions to persons other than young persons and children.

A.D. 1934.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Amendment Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed with the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Ordinance, 1933, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.



2. Section six of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by repealing paragraph (b) thereof and substituting the following :—

“(b) extending any of the provisions of this Ordinance which apply to young persons or to children to persons who are not young persons or children, as the case may be, but are under the age of eighteen years, in respect of any occupation or occupations in which the employment of such persons may seem deleterious.”
