ORDINANCE NO. 15th OF 1933.

AN ORDINANCE to validate certain acts and proceedings of the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Commissioners. A.D. 1933.

WHEREAS by section eight of the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, Chapter 96, there is constituted a body corporate by the name and style of "the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Commissioners," consisting of six persons appointed by the Governor in Council to hold office for two years but eligible for re-appointment and the Mayor of Georgetown for the time being;

And whereas by virtue of the said Ordinance the Governor in Council did appoint persons to be Commissioners;

And whereas after the termination of two years and their consequent cessation of office certain persons continued to act as Commissioners without having been re-appointed during the period from the second day of April, nineteen hundred and thirty-one to the twenty-fourth day of January, nineteen hundred and thirty-three inclusive ;

And whereas it is desirable and expedient that all powers purporting to have been exercised and acts purporting to have been done by the Commissioners during the said period shall be validated :

Be it, therefore, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short Title.


1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Commissioners (Validation) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be construed with the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Cap. 96.

Validation of acts and proceedings from the 2nd of April, 1931, to the 24th of January, 1933.

2. All powers which purporting to have been exercised, and all proceedings and acts which purporting to have been taken and done by and on behalf of the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Commissioners during the period from the second day of April, nineteen hundred and thirty-one to the twenty-fourth day of January nineteen hundred and thirty-three, inclusive, are hereby validated and shall be deemed to have been exercised taken and done under the authority and in pursuance of the Principal Ordinance.
