BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. 19. OF 1933.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sea Defence Ordinance, 1933, with respect to the amounts to be voted in pursuance of paragraph (A) of sub-section (2) of section eighteen, and with respect to rates for nineteen hundred and thirty-three.

A.D. 1933.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sea Defence (Amendment) Ordinance, 1933, and shall be construed with the Sea Defence Ordinance, 1933, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short Title.

New paragraph substituted for paragraph (a) of section 18 (2) of No. 11 of 1933.

2. The following is substituted for paragraph (a) of sub-section (2) of section eighteen of the Principal Ordinance—

“(a) an amount to be voted by the Legislative Council equal to one-half of the estimated expenditure of the Board as shown in the Board’s estimate presented to the Council, provided always that the amounts voted in pursuance of this paragraph shall not exceed fifty thousand dollars in any one year.”

Amendments of Principal Ordinance with respect to rates for 1933.

3. The amendments specified in the second column of the Schedule to this Ordinance, which relate to minor details, shall be made in the provisions of the Third Schedule to the Principal Ordinance specified in the first column of the Schedule.



SCHEDULE.

MINOR AMENDMENTS OF THIRD SCHEDULE OF PRINCIPAL ORDINANCE.

Section Amended.	Nature of Amendments.
Section 1	... In sub-section (1) for the words from “on” in the first line to “the appointed day” in the second line there shall be substituted the words “not later than the nineteenth day of August nineteen hundred and thirty-three.” In sub-section (2) for the words “appointed day” there shall be substituted the “nineteenth day of August nineteen hundred and thirty-three.”
Section 2	... For the words “fifteenth day of June” there shall be inserted the words “first day of October.”
Section 3	... For the word “July” there shall be inserted the word “October,” and for the words “thirty-first day of October” there shall be inserted the words “fifteenth day of December.”
