BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. 22. OF 1934.

AN ORDINANCE to allow and confirm certain additional expenditure incurred in the year ended thirty-first day of December, 1933. A.D. 1934.

WHEREAS expenditure was necessarily incurred during the year ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1933, on certain services approved by the Legislative Council on Supplementary Estimate but not provided for by the Appropriation Ordinance, 1933 : No. 1 of 1933.

Be it, therefore, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council, thereof, as follows :—


Short Title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1933) Ordinance, 1934.

Supplementary amount authorised from financial year 1933. No. 1 of 1933. 2. The expenditure during the year ended on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three, to the amount of two hundred and twelve thousand, four hundred and thirty-four dollars, and ninety-two cents on certain services set forth in the Schedule to this Ordinance and not provided for or not fully provided for by the Appropriation Ordinance, 1933, is hereby allowed and confirmed.
