### ORDINANCE NO. 25 OF 1934.

IN ORDINANCE to extend the operation of the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance, 1932, as amended by the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance (No. 2), 1933. A.D. 1934.

**W**HEREAS the operation of the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance, 1932, was extended to the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and thirty-four;

And whereas it is expedient further to extend the operation of the said Ordinance, as amended by the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance (No. 2), 1933:

Be it, therefore, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—



1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed with the Rice (Export Trade) Ordinance, 1932, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any amending Ordinance.
