BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. 31. OF 1934.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Sugar Experiment Stations Ordinance, 1932, with respect to the times for levy and collection of rates.

A.D. 1934.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Sugar Experiment Stations Ordinance, (No. 2) 1934, and shall be construed with the Sugar Experiment Stations Ordinance, 1932, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any amending Ordinance.

Rate to be
levied on

2. Section eight of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by substituting the following for sub-section (1):—

“(1) The Committee shall in each year charge, levy and collect in respect of every sugar plantation a rate to be fixed annually of not more than thirty cents for each acre of land cultivated in sugar cane: provided always that no rate shall be chargeable where the area so cultivated does not exceed twenty-five acres and is cultivated by one person. Sixty per centum of the rates shall be charged, levied and collected on or before the thirty-first day of January, and forty per centum on or before the thirtieth day of June, in each year.”

(b) by substituting the following for sub-section (4):—

“(4) The proprietor of every sugar plantation shall pay the rates charged thereon to the Secretary in two proportionate instalments as aforesaid, the first before the first day of February, and the second before the first day of July, in each year.”
