BRITISH GUIANA.

ORDINANCE NO. 28 OF 1934.

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Notaries Ordinance, 1932, by making provision for the registration of Public Notaries authorised to act as such by the Master of the Faculties.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Notaries Ordinance, 1934, and shall be construed with the Public Notaries Ordinance, 1932, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Exclusion of Notaries appointed by the Master of the Faculties from other sections of Ordinance.

Registration.

2. The following section is hereby added to the Principal Ordinance as section eight thereof;—

“ 8.—(1) Sections two to seven, inclusive, of this Ordinance shall not apply to any person who by virtue of a faculty granted by the Master of the Faculties in England is authorised to act as a public notary in this Colony or any part thereof.

(2) The Registrar of the Supreme Court shall enter in a separate part of the register kept by him in accordance with section four of this ordinance the name of any person who by virtue of a faculty granted by the Master of the Faculties in England is authorised to act as a public notary in this colony or any part thereof and who has complied with the provisions of sub-section (3) of this section.


(3) Any person who desires to be registered under this section shall make application in writing to the Registrar and shall produce to him his notarial faculty duly registered and subscribed by the Clerk of the Crown in Chancery.

(4) The Registrar shall remove from the register aforesaid the name of any notary who has been struck off the roll of public notaries by the Court of Faculties.”

Amendment to long title of Ord. 52 of 1932.

3. The long title of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words “ and for the registration of Notaries authorised to act as such by the Master of Faculties ” after the word “ Notaries.”
