ORDINANCE 2 NO. OF 1930.

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the supplies granted in this Session of the Legislative Council.

A.D. 1930.

WHEREAS of the amount of five millions four hundred and seventeen thousand two hundred and sixty dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of this Colony, and for other purposes, for the year to end on the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty, the sum of one million nine hundred and fifty-three thousand and ninety-nine dollars has been provided for by Law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony of three million four hundred and sixty-four thousand one hundred and sixty-one dollars.

Be it, therefore, enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short Title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1930.

Treasurer

Government. 2. The Treasurer of the Colony shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of the Colony a sum not exceeding in the aggregate three million four hundred and sixty-four thousand one hundred and sixty-one dollars as set forth in the schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of this Colony, and for other purposes during the year ending the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.
