# BRITISH GUIANA.

[THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.]

ORDINANCE NO. 10 OF 1930.

AN ORDINANCE to amplify the provisions of the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, 1929, with respect to the levying of a rate thereunder. A.D. 1930.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, 1930, and shall be construed with the Georgetown Sewerage and Water Ordinance, 1929, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, Short Title. No. 19 of 1929.



2. During such time as the Council may be responsible for providing on the annual estimates the interest on money advanced by the Government for the use of the Council in respect of the execution of improvement works, it shall be lawful for the Council to include in the sum to be levied by the rate under section twenty-two of the Principal Ordinance the amount of any such interest.

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the twentieth day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine.
