ORDINANCE NO. 14 OF 1929

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Mining (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1920, by vesting in the Governor-in-Council the power to make Regulations by the said Ordinance conferred on the Governor and Court of Policy. A.D. 1929. —

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Mining Regulations Ordinance, 1929, and shall be construed with the Mining (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1920, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance. Short Title.

2.—(1) Section one hundred of the Principal Ordinance is amended as follows :—

In sub-section (1) the words

“Governor-in-Council may make Regulations” are substituted for

“the Governor and Court of Policy may make Regulations and when made may alter, amend or revoke such Regulations,”


(2) In sub-section (2) the words

“Governor-in-Council” are substituted for

“Governor and Court of Policy.”

(3) Sub-section (4) is hereby repealed.
