ORDINANCE NO. 15 OF 1929.

AN ORDINANCE to facilitate the Proof of Service of Process in Proceedings in the Magistrates' Courts under the Petty Debts Recovery Ordinance, 1893, the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1893, and the Indictable Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1893.

A.D. 1929.

BE it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Service of Process Ordinance, 1929. Short Title.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Petty Debts Recovery Ordinance, 1893, the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1893, or the Indictable Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1893, in any proceeding in any Magistrate's Court in which it becomes necessary to prove the service of any summons, notice, order

or other process whatsoever issued under any of the said Ordinances and served by a bailiff or constable a return of service in the form in the Schedule hereto purporting to be signed by a bailiff or constable shall be received as *prima facie* evidence of the facts stated in such return without proof of the signature or of the official character of such bailiff or constable.

3. Sub-section (2) of section twelve and sub-section (2) of section sixteen of the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1893, and sub-section (5) of section fifty-two of the Indictable Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1893, are hereby repealed.
