A.D. 1919. AN ORDINANCE to amend the Miscellaneous Licences Ordinance, 1861.

 $\mathbf{B}^{\mathbf{E}}$ it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice . and consent of the Court of Policy thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Miscellaneous Licences Ordinance, 1861, Amendment Ordinance, 1919, and shall be read and construed as one with the Miscellaneous Licences Ordinance, 1861, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and with any amending Ordinance.

Amendment of Section 12 of Ordinance 2 of 1861. See under "Licences." 2. Section twelve of the Principal Ordinance shall be amended by the insertion after the words "Colonial Taxes" in the third line, of the words "Or who fails to pay any instalment due in respect of any licence issued to him under the said provisions" and by the insertion at the end of sub-section (b) of the following words "And shall if he has at the time of conviction taken out a licence but is in default of payment of the second instalment pay in addition with all costs the amount due in respect of such instalment."
