**B**E it enacted by the Governor of British Guiana, with the advice and consent of the Court of Policy thereof, as follows:—

1. The Customs entry relating to imported goods shall for the purposes of the Merchandise Marks Ordinance, 1888, be deemed to be a trade description applied to the goods.
