## COMMENCEMENT OF MEETING

The Meeting commenced at 4.05 p.m.

## PURPOSE OF MEETING

The meeting was convened to consider the duplication in the nominations of Opposition Alternate Members on the Sectoral Committees.

The Chairman drew Members' attention to paragraph 2 of Resolution No. 19 dated $15^{\text {th }}$ May. 2003 which states:
"The Sectoral Committees shall consist of seven (7) members, four ( 4 ) representing the Government and three (3) representing the Opposition. The Government and Opposition are entitled to elect one alternate member each for each Sectoral Committee.

He said that the Committee of Selection in nominating members to the various Committees on $14^{\text {th }}$ December, 2007 had erred, in that, it allowed each Opposition Party to nominate Alternate Members to the Sectoral Committees.

The Chairman then invited suggestions as to which Opposition Alternates should remain on the Sectoral Committees.

The Deputy Speaker pointed out that since the AFC had a substantive Member on each Sectoral Committee the Alternates of the PNCR - $1 G$ should remain as Opposition Alternates on the Committees.

The Committee agreed to the Deputy Speaker's proposal.
Mr Ramjattan in acknowledging the error stated that there might be a need for the Standing Orders to be amended to accommodate a second Opposition Alternate.

The Chairman reminded Mr. Ramjattan that in other legislatures there was no representation from the smaller parties at the level of Committees.
