THE GUYANA RICE DEVELOPMENT BOARD ACT 1994.

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 59(3)
OF THE GUYANA RICE DEVELOPMENT BOARD ACT 1994, I MAKE
THE FOLLOWING ORDER :-

Citation and
Commencement.

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Rice Milling and Marketing Authority (Dissolution) Order 2007 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 19th December, 1996.

Interpretation.

2. In this Order –

(a) "appointed day" means the day on which this Order is deemed to have come into operation;

(b) "Authority" means the Guyana Rice Milling and Marketing Authority, established by section 8 of the Rice (Regulation of Manufacturing and Marketing) Act 1985;

(c) "Company" means the MARDS Rice Milling Complex Limited,

No. 29 of 1991

a company incorporated under the Companies Act, Cap. 89:01 and continued in force under the Companies Act 1991;

Dissolution of
the Authority.

3. The Authority is dissolved.

Vesting of
property.

4. From the appointed day all assets and other property whether movable or immovable including the immovable property mentioned in the Schedule (including rights and interests therein) of the Authority is vested in the Company and in respect of such immovable property so vested in the Company, the Registrar of Deeds shall take due notice thereof and shall make such annotations in the records as may be necessary.


5. All contracts, deeds, bonds, guarantees, agreements or other instruments or documents relating to the assets of the Authority, which were subsisting immediately before the appointed day shall be of full force and effect in favour of the Company and be enforceable as fully and effectually as if, instead of the Authority, the Company had been named therein or had been a party thereto.

"A piece or parcel of land known as tract A, B, C, being a portion of or part of a tract 7.48 (seven decimal four eight) acres situate in the town of Anna Regina, in the county of Essequibo, Republic of Guyana, the said portion of land being shown on a plan by M.S.
