

AN ACT to validate the Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2003 (No. 29 of 2003) published in the **Gazette** on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2003.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2003] Validation Act 2004 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2003.

Validation of Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2003, indemnity.

No. 29 of 2003

Cap. 82:01

2. (1) The Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2003 (No. 29 of 2003) which was made on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2003 under Section 8 of the Customs Act and published in the **Gazette** on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2003 shall not be invalid, notwithstanding anything in Section 9 (4) of the Customs Act, by reason only of the lodging of the Order otherwise than in accordance with the provisions of subsection (1) of Section 9 of the Customs Act or by any other reason; the said Order is hereby deemed to be lawfully and validly lodged.

(2) The confirmation on 23<sup>rd</sup> October, 2003 by the National Assembly of the said Customs Duties Order hereby deemed to be lawfully and validly done.

(3) The said Customs Duties Order is hereby deemed to be properly, lawfully and validly made, published and confirmed by the National Assembly on 23<sup>rd</sup> October, 2003 and to be of full legal force and validity, notwithstanding anything in any law, and all acts and things done or omitted in good faith during the period commencing 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2003 and ending 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2004 by all persons and which would have been lawful if this Act had been in force shall be deemed to have been lawfully and validly done, and all persons are hereby discharged and indemnified against all other persons from all legal proceedings in respect of, or consequent on, such acts.

(4) The Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 2003 (No. 29 of 2003) is hereby revoked with effect from 10<sup>th</sup> February, 2004.
