AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the financial year ending 31st December 2005, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of those sums for specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 1 for 2005) Act 2005.

Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised

No. 20 of 2003

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund for such sums, not exceeding in the aggregate the gross of one billion, three hundred and seventy-six million, seven hundred and fifty-two thousand, two hundred and ninety-five dollars (\$1,376,752,295), necessary to meet the expenditure of Guyana for the fiscal year ending on 31st December, 2005, is hereby authorized in accordance with article 219 of the Constitution and sections 24 and 41 of the Fiscal Management and Accountability Act 2003.

Appropriation. Schedule.

3. Every sum set out in the Schedule is hereby appropriated for the purposes specified therein with effect from 1st January, 2005.
