Short title and construction. Cap. 99:01

- 1. (1) This Act, which amends the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, may be cited as the Employment of Young Persons and Children (Amendment) Act 1983.
- As from the commencement of this Act, the Principal Act may be cited as the Employment of Young Persons and Children Act, and section 1 of the Principal Act and all other laws wherein the Principal Act is mentioned shall have effect accordingly.
