SECTION

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of the Principal Act.

AN ACT to amend the Shops (Consolidation) Act.

A.D. 1982 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act, which amends the Shops (Consolidation) Act, may
Cap. 91:04 be cited as the Shops (Consolidation) (Amendment) Act 1982

Amendment of the Principal Act. 2. The Principal Act is hereby amended as follows —

(a) in section 2, by the substitution for the definition 'urban area' of the following definition —
Cap. 28:01 "urban area" means the area that comprised the city of Georgetown immediately before the commencement of the Municipal and District Councils Act and an area within one mile of the eastern boundary thereof and the area that comprised the town of New Amsterdam immediately before the commencement of the Municipal and District Councils Act.;

Cap. 89:01

(b) in the First Schedule, under the heading 'URBAN AREAS' —

(i) by the substitution for the words commencing "Weekdays" and ending "12 noon" of the following words —

"Weekdays, other than
Mondays, Fridays,
public holidays and
half-holidays

—7.30 a.m. (07:30 hrs)
to 4 p.m. (16:00 hrs).

Mondays and Fridays —9.30 a.m. (09:30 hrs)
to 6.15 p.m. (18:15 hrs).

Half-holidays —7.30 a.m. (07:30 hrs)
to 12 noon (12:00 hrs)."

(ii) by the substitution for the second proviso of the following proviso —

"Provided further that where a shop is kept open between the hours of 9.30 a.m. (09:30 hrs) and 6.15 p.m. (18:15 hrs) on any day the occupier of that shop shall allow to each shop assistant an interval from work of one-quarter of an hour between the hours of 4 p.m. (16:00 hrs) and 5 p.m. (17:00 hrs)."
