An Act to amend the Defence Act

A. D. 1974. Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act, which amends the Defence Act, may be cited
Cap. 15:01. as the Defence (Amendment) Act 1974.

Amendment 2. Section 212 of the Principal Act is hereby amended in
of section the following respects —
212 of the
Defence Act.

- (a) by renumbering the section as section 212(1); and
- (b) by the addition of the following subsection as subsection (2) —

“(2) The pensions and gratuities of officers and soldiers and of their dependants surviving them payable by virtue of regulations made under subsection (1) shall be a charge upon the Consolidated Fund.”.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Defence Act (Chapter 15:01) to charge upon the Consolidated Fund the pensions and gratuities of officers and soldiers of the Guyana Defence Force and of their dependants surviving them.
