THE NEW AMSTERDAM TOWN COUNCIL (APPRAISEMENT) BILL 1974

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title.
2. Order to enable the making of appraisements of properties in New Amsterdam deemed to have been made.

A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to provide for the making of appraisements in the Town of New Amsterdam pursuant to the continuance in operation of certain provisions of the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance.

A.D. 1974 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the New Amsterdam Town Council (Appraisalment) Act 1974.

Order to enable the making of appraisements of properties in New Amsterdam deemed to have been made. 2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, an order under section 136 of the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance (continued in force by section 44 of the Valuation for Rating Purposes Act) for the purpose of extending to the 31st December, 1975 the period within which the New Amsterdam Town Council shall order and direct the general appraisalment of all properties in the Town of New Amsterdam shall for all purposes be deemed to have been duly made and to have come into operation on 1st January, 1974.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Cap. 28:04 This Bill seeks to provide for the general appraisalment of all properties in the Town of New Amsterdam to be continued in pursuance of section 136 of the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance the continued operation of which was effected by section 44 of the Valuation for Rating Purposes Act until such time as properties in New Amsterdam can be valued by the valuation officers under the Valuation for Rating Purposes Act.
