ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of section 44 of the Valuation for Rating Purposes Act.

ment was made prior to the posting up of copies of the appraisalment, such publication and such posting up shall be deemed to have been lawfully and validly effected:

Provided that in relation to any such appraisalment subsection (2) (a) of section 101 of the Local Government Ordinance (in operation at 30th December, 1973 by virtue of section 44(1) of the Principal Act prior to its amendment by section (2) shall be construed and have effect as requiring any appeal to be made within twenty-one days after the commencement of this Act and in the manner otherwise required by the said subsection (2) (a).

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to enable a local authority to post up copies of an appraisalment before, simultaneously with, or after, notice of completion of the appraisalment has been published in the *Gazette*. The Bill also seeks to validate any previous appraisalment in so far as publication in the *Gazette* of the notice of completion was effected before copies of the completed appraisalment were posted up, subject to a right of appeal exerciseable within twenty-one days after the coming into operation of the legislation.
