RENT CONTROL (SPECIAL PROVISIONS) BILL 1979

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title and commencement.
2. Interpretation.
3. Extension of the Principal Act.

A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to make provision for a further extension of the period during which rents will be controlled and for matters connected therewith.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Rent Control (Special Provisions) Act 1979 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 31st December, 1978.

Interpreta-
tion.

2. In this Act —

Cap. 36:25.

“the Principal Act” means the rent Control (Special Provisions) Act.

Extension
of the

3. Anything in the Principal Act to the contrary notwithstanding, the Rent Control (Special Provisions) Act (Extension) Order 1977 shall, with effect from the coming into operation of this Act, be construed and have effect with the following modification, that is to say, as if a reference to 31st December, 1979, had been substituted for the reference to 31st December, 1978.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Rent Control (Special Provisions) Act, Cap. 36:25, imposed a freeze on rentals until 31st December, 1978. This Bill seeks to make provision for a further extension of that period.
