APPROPRIATION BILL 1979

ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

Section

1. Short title.
2. Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorized.
3. Appropriation.

SCHEDULE

A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the financial year ending 31st December, 1979, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for the appropriation of that sum for specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

A.D. 1979 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act 1979.

2. The Accountant General may, on the warrant of the Minister, issue from the Consolidated Fund a sum not exceeding in the aggregate the gross amount of six hundred and twenty-seven million, seven hundred and seven thousand, one hundred and fifteen dollars (\$627,707,115)* for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government and for other purposes for the financial year ending on the 31st December, 1979, and before that date the appropriate accounting officers shall pay in to the Accountant General for deposit into the Consolidated Fund, the sums totalling seven million, seventy-six thousand, nine hundred and ninety-seven dollars (\$7,076,997) shown as appropriations-in-aid in the last column of the schedule, thereby making the issues from the Consolidated Fund to meet expenditure for the financial year, not exceeding in the aggregate the net sum of six hundred and twenty million, six hundred and thirty thousand, one hundred and eighteen dollars (\$620,630,118).

Appropriation.

3. The net sum granted in section 2 is hereby appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the schedule pursuant to and in accordance with Article 111(2) of the Constitution with effect from 1st January, 1979.
