Short Title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Copyright (Repeal) Act, 1966.
2. The Copyright Ordinance is hereby repealed.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Copyright Act, 1956 of the United Kingdom which replaces the Copyright Act, 1911, has been extended to this country by the Copyright (British Guiana) Order, 1966. Most of the provisions of the Copyright Act, 1956, will come into operation in this country on the 5th June, 1966. Sections 21 and 22 of the Copyright Act, 1956, contain provisions corresponding to the provisions of the Copyright Ordinance and it is therefore desirable that the Ordinance be repealed. This Bill seeks to provide accordingly.
