APPROPRIATION BILL, 1966

Intituled

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the supplies granted in the current session of the Legislature.

WHEREAS of the amount of eighty-four million two hundred and nine thousand six hundred and thirty dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of British Guiana and other purposes, for the year commencing the 1st day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-six, the sum of fifteen million two hundred and thirteen thousand three hundred and eighty-three dollars is chargeable by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of British Guiana of sixty-eight million nine hundred and nintey-six thousand two hundred and forty-seven dollars.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, Short title. 1966.

Schedule.

2. The Accountant General shall on the warrant of the Governor or of the Minister responsible for finance, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing on the 1st January, 1966, and other resources of British Guiana a sum not exceeding in the aggregate sixty-eight million nine hundred and ninety six thousand two hundred and forty seven dollars as set out in the schedule to this Ordinance for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes during the said year.
