PENSIONS (SPECIAL PROVISION) BILL, 1967.

Arrangement of Sections

1. Short title.
2. Certain public service of three officers to be taken into account as pensionable service.

A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to make special provision with respect to the pensionable public service of Doctors Lionel Soobhakaran Jaikaran, Maurice Orlando Luck and Hardutt Singh.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

A.D. 1967

1. This Act may be cited as the Pensions (Special Provision) Act, 1967. Short title.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary provided by any Ordinance in that behalf, such period of acting service by any public officer named in the first column of the schedule to this Act as is mentioned in the second column of the said schedule in relation to such officer shall be taken into account as pensionable service. Certain public service of three officers to be taken into account as pensionable service.

SCHEDULE

Name of Officer	Period of service
Dr. L. S. Jaikaran	From 8th August, 1933 to 31st December, 1937 (both dates inclusive).
Dr. M. O. Luck	From 30th April, 1935 to 31st December, 1938 (both dates inclusive).
Dr. H. Singh	From 18th November, 1940 to 31st December, 1942 (both dates inclusive).

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

On account of special circumstances, it is considered just that periods of acting service by three medical officers, prior to their permanent appointments to the public service, should be reckoned as pensionable, though no pension is payable under the relevant pension laws in respect of any such period. This Bill seeks to provide accordingly
