AN ACT to provide for the grant of a gratuity to the widow of the late Harrie Emile Belgrave.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

A.D. 1967

1. This Act may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Adaptation and Modification) (Belgrave Gratuity) Act, 1967. Short title.

2. In this Act —

Interpretation.

“the Principal Ordinance” means the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same; Cap. 152.
“the Council” has the same meaning as in the Principal Ordinance.

3. Section 96 of the Principal Ordinance shall be deemed to authorise the grant, in accordance with the provisions thereof save as otherwise provided by this Act, of a gratuity of four thousand and twenty-six dollars and sixty-seven cents to the widow of the late Harrie Emile Belgrave in respect of his service of the Council and, for the purpose, the said provisions shall be construed with such modifications and adaptations as are necessary. Authority to grant a gratuity to the widow of the late Harrie Emile Belgrave.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. Prior to his death in 1946, the late Harrie Emile Belgrave was employed in the service of the Georgetown Town Council for a period of fifty-two years.

2. His death occurring shortly after his retirement from the Council, the late Belgrave only enjoyed pensionable benefits for a short period, nor was his widow entitled to a gratuity under the provisions of the relevant law.

3. This Bill accordingly seeks to provide for the latter.
