APPROPRIATION BILL, 1968

Arrangement of Sections

Section

1. Short title.
2. Issue of \$122,164,015 from Consolidated Fund authorised.

SCHEDULE

A BILL

Intituled

An Act to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the year ending the 31st December, 1968, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for appropriation of that sum for specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

A.D. 1968.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1968.

Short title.

2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum of one hundred and twenty-two million, one hundred and sixty-four thousand, and fifteen dollars is hereby authorised for meeting expenditure for the service of the year ending 31st December, 1968 in the sums itemised in the schedule to this Act; and every sum so itemised is, for the purposes particularized in relation thereto in the said year's estimates approved by the National Assembly under the Division or Head number mentioned in such item, hereby appropriated out of the said sum of one hundred and twenty-two million, one hundred and sixty-four thousand, and fifteen dollars.
